



SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT

FLRC SCHOLARSHIP

The Finger Lakes Runners Club is proud to announce the Joseph P. Reynolds scholarship for high school seniors who have plans for continuing their education and have participated in their running community during their high school experience.

Program/Eligibility

- A minimum of two unrestricted \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to deserving applicants who are at the completion of their high school education, will be continuing their education after high school, and have participated in their local running community during their high school experience. Qualifying activities may include but are not limited to interscholastic cross country, track and field, FLRC events, other running events, and volunteering in running-related activities.
- Eligible students must reside in Tompkins or a surrounding County.
- FLRC membership is not required.

Process

- To apply, applicants must submit an essay describing their academic, extracurricular, and running achievements. They are asked to include any plans they may have for running beyond high school and the personal benefits they have gained by participating in the sport. The essay should also outline how this scholarship will assist in furthering their education.
- Applicants should describe any relationship they have with the Finger Lakes Runners Club; for example, if they have run or volunteered at an FLRC race. Applicants are also asked to include affiliations with any other running organizations.
- Applicants must submit two letters of recommendation, one focusing on their academic experience and another focusing on their running experience. Applicants are asked not to send transcripts or additional materials for consideration, as these will not be reviewed.
