

HOW TO GET FINANCIAL AID FOR COLLEGE



MAKE SURE YOU GET AS MUCH FINANCIAL AID AS POSSIBLE BY FOLLOWING THESE STEPS.

Right Now: Create your FSA ID



This is required prior to completing the FAFSA and only takes a moment.

Go to studentaid.gov/help/fsa-id
You'll need your Social Security number (SSN) (if applicable) and your own email address to create an FSA ID.



After December 1: Complete your FAFSA Go to fafsa.gov

Students will need:

- Parent first and last name
- Parent e-mail
- Parent date of birth
- Parent social security number (if they have one)

NYS Financial Aid
